Sue will appear on Helen Mayhew's JazzJam Show on 21st Feb at 1pm to talk about her upcoming tour and album and the free download track, Inbetween, which is now available. On 2nd March Sue will be in session and interviewed by Trudy Kerr for the jazz show broadcast on BBC Radio Kent, Surrey and Sussex.

The new song, Inbtween, has been specially written and recorded by Sue and her band. The sassy trumpet tune is available to download for free from www.SueRichardson.biz. It is one of the new songs written by Sue that she will be performing on her UK Tour. The tour kicks off in a week's time at Pizza Express Dean St, London (22nd Feb) and is sponsored by Jazz Services.

Sue Richardson is the unusual combination of female jazz trumpet player, singer and composer. Her performances are a wonderful mix of breathy vocals, swinging trumpet and her own modern compositions and arrangements of jazz standards.

Touring with big bands by the age of 16, Sue has a musical past that includes many years travelling the world, gigging in over 50 countries in hotels, jazz clubs and on cruise ships. You can even hear her recorded version of The Girl From Ipanema being played in Rio in the famous bar where the song was written. She has worked for the BBC, performing at The Last Night of The Proms and gaining a Blue Peter badge for her singing!

Since being tipped for the top by Jazzwise in January '08, Sue Richardson's career has been going from strength to strength. She featured on Ian Shaw's tribute to Humph, Sad Sweet Song, and as a result guests with the Humphrey Lyttelton Band. She opened the London Jazz Festival in 2007 and at the festival in 2008 appeared at The Royal Opera House with Liane Carroll. Sue's 2009 bookings included The 606, Ronnie Scotts, Swanage Jazz Festival and The Sage in Gateshead.
